This is what we talked about:

The school councillors were told that each class will hold a class meeting after each school meeting and they will write their classes comments into their book.

Mrs Crow came to talk to the school councillors about using the shelter as a reading area. The children liked this idea however they are concerned that the shelter roof is leaking.
