

 <p>English</p> <p>In English we will read lots of Greek myths and will identify their different plots but also common features and themes. We will use the myth Theseus and the Minotaur as the inspiration for our TRAWL writing where we will focus on redrafting and editing our writing. In Guided Reading we will use Bug Club focussing on predicting and answering questions. We will look at how conjunctions can be used to create complex sentences. There will be a focus on using neat, fluent and joined up handwriting in our written work.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>In Maths we continue to use practical resources such as double-sided counters and part whole models to solve multiplication and division problems. Time will be provided for children to use Times Tables Rock stars in class gaining a quick recall of the 3x 4x tables. The children will be adding and subtracting money using the formal methods introduced in the autumn term. They will interpret pictograms and bar charts.</p> 	<p>Science</p> <p>In our Food and our bodies topic we will learn that animals and human need the right types and amounts of nutrition. WE will identify that humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support.</p> <p>In the Forces and Magnets unit: we will investigate how magnets attract and repel some materials and not others and compare and group objects according to whether they are magnetic or not.</p> 
<p>P.E & French</p> <p>In P.E all children will have a weekly swimming lesson on Tuesdays and the class will be split between two instructors.
