

<p>English</p> <p>In English we will use texts based around our topic including Stone Age Boy, How to wash a Woolly Mammoth and the Iron Man to write character descriptions, letters, instructions, and our own stories. Shape poems will be on a Christmas theme. In Guided Reading we will use Bug Club weekly in groups. Our SPAG sessions focus on developing expanded noun phrases. There will be a focus on using neat, fluent and joined up handwriting in our written work.</p> 	<p>Maths</p> <p>In Maths we continue to use practical resources such as Base Ten on our place value grids to understand the concept of Place Value within 1000 as well as addition and subtraction within 3-digit numbers. We will be adding and subtracting single digit and tens to and from 3-digit numbers using 'exchange.' We will practise our 2x, 5x, 10 x tables and will begin to learn our 3x, 4x and 8x tables.</p> 	<p>Science</p> <p>In our Rocks and Soils topic we will be investigating different rocks, comparing and grouping them based on their appearance and properties. We will carry out investigations on soils. We will learn about the famous woman scientist Mary Anning who found fossils of dinosaurs in England.</p> <p>In the Nappy Challenge unit: we will carry out investigations on nappies to discover what is inside of them and which nappy holds the most water!</p> 
<p>P.E & French</p> <p>In P.E we will take part in multi skills sessions led by Mrs Moore. Some children will have a weekly swimming lesson and the non-swimmers have a specialist PE teacher at this time. They will learn new playground games, Tag Rugby and gymnastics (balancing)</p> <p>In French we are learning how to say hello and answer if we are well.
