









<p>English</p> <p>In English we will use texts based around our Rainforest topic including The Great Kapok Tree, The Black Hat, The Rainforest grew all around to write letters and stories. We will listen to and write animal poems. In Guided Reading the children will be reading books from the appropriate book band or/and a whole class text. Our SPAG sessions focus on spelling Common Exception words, tenses and There will be a focus on using neat, fluent and joined up handwriting in our written work.</p> 	<p>Maths</p> <p>In Maths we will be focussing on having a quick recall of times tables including 10,2,5,3,4 and 8 and will play Times Tables Rock stars in school. We will be revising column addition and subtraction and focussing on the children having a quick recall of addition and subtraction facts. Column multiplication will be revised as this was taught during lockdown and after assessing the children, we will focus on the aspects that require consolidation. Bar graphs and pictograms will be covered in or science work. Children will measure using mm, cm, and metres and will be able to convert measurements.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>In our How does your garden grow topic we will be learning about the different parts of plants, what plants need to live, water transportation in plants and pollination.</p>  <p>In our Rocks and Soils topic we will be investigating different rocks, comparing and grouping them based on their appearance and properties. We will carry out investigations on soils. We will learn about the famous woman scientist Mary Anning.</p>
<p>PE and French</p> <p>In P.E we will take part in tennis sessions and athletics led by Mr Brown. We will take part in a weekly netball lesson.</p>  <p>In French we will be learning to name parts of the body and animals.</p>	<p>Year 3 Curriculum Summer Term</p> <p>There will be some flexibility in our curriculum to ensure children recover lost learning and revisit concepts due to Covid 19 and the resulting school closure.</p>  <p>Books we will read together: The Abominables- Eva Ibbotson</p>	<p>Computing and Design Technology</p> <p>In Computing we will be using chrome books to combine text and pictures. <p>Creative Arts</p> <p>In Art the children will be exploring the art work of Henri Rousseau and will create pictures of rainforest animals using paint and pastels. We will continue with weekly Draw With Rob sessions.</p>  <p>In Music children will learn to play the glockenspiel. Due to Covid rules and children not being allowed to sing children will use technology to create music.</p>	<p>Topic</p> <p>In Geography we will learning about Rainforests and in particular the Amazon Rainforest. We will be learning about the different layers of trees, the animals that live there and the destruction of the Rainforest.</p>  <p>In History we will be learning about transport changes in our local area. We will focus on the founder of the modern railway George Stephenson who was born locally.</p>	<p>RE and PSHE</p> <p>In RE we will be learning about Islam finding out about Mohammed and where Islam was founded. We will learn about their beliefs, symbols and some festivals.</p>  <p>In PSHE we will be learning about money, what influences people's choices about spending and saving. How people can keep track of their money.</p> <p>In our online safety lessons children will be discussing the well-being of using technology and why some online activities have age restrictions.</p>
