Vocabulary	
Fish	Fish live in water and they lay their eggs in water. They have fins instead of lungs.
Reptiles	Live on land and in water. They lay their eggs on land. They have scales and are cold blooded. This means they cannot keep warm themselves and need to be in a warm place.
Amphibians	Live on land on in water and they lay their eggs in water.
Mammals	Usually have hair or fur. Humans are mammals. Mammal's babies are born alive and the mothers feed their babies milk.
Birds	Birds have a beak, wings, feathers and two legs. They lay eggs.
