We will identify the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense. We will look at facial features and describe these features of our friends.</p> <p>We will look at the seasonal changes between autumn and winter. We will discuss the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees.</p>

Children will learn to develop a range of basic skills, actions and ideas. Children will begin to remember and repeat simple skills and actions with increasing control, showing agility, balance and coordination. Children will apply these actions and skills in isolation and in a combination.
