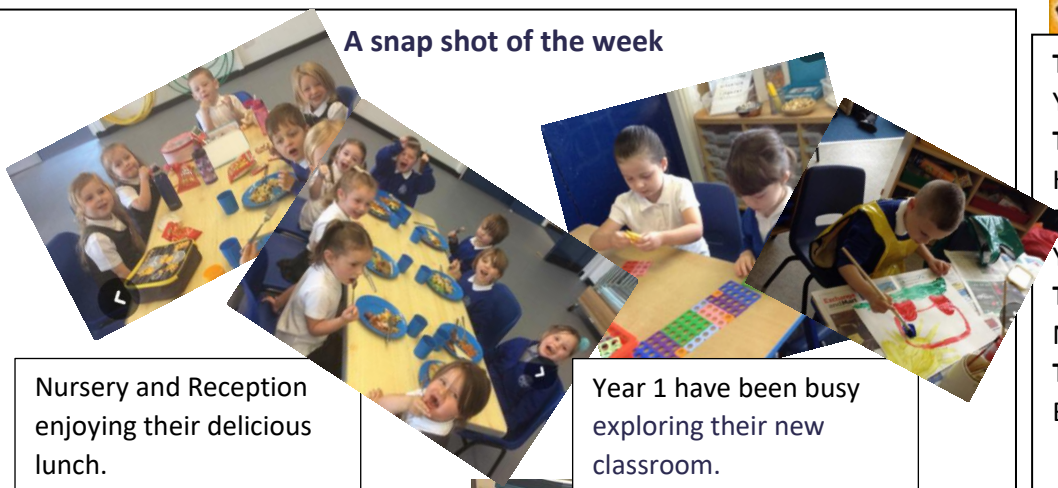

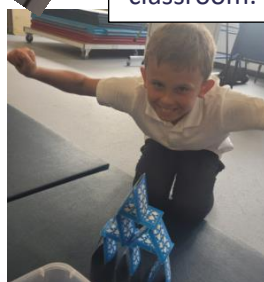
A snap shot of the week
