











<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>In English we will use texts including Bog Baby and Meerkat Mail in our 'Talk for Writing lessons' The children will learn the text, then change features of it in our writing. We will be focussing on expanding our sentences by using noun phrases, using further punctuation, connectives such as 'when, because, if' to improve sentences. Children will have either a daily RWI phonics lessons or a VIPERS lesson, both will include daily reading.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>In Maths we will continue to use practical resources and have a faster recall of key number facts through our daily additional 'Mastery' lessons. We will be introduced to Times Tables Rockstars.</p> <p><u>Addition and subtraction</u> - adding and subtracting numbers including 2 Digit numbers.</p> <p><u>Shape</u>- recognise 2D and 3D shapes, counting faces, edges and vertices. Money – adding coins and notes. Multiplication – beginning to learn facts for 2x, 5x and 10x tables.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>In our Materials topic we will Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses. Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.</p> <p>We will observe bulbs growing in our classroom and how our local environment is changing in Winter and Spring.</p>

<p>Creative Arts</p> <p>In Art we will be we will develop our observational drawing skills further and explore monoprint.</p>  <p>In Music we will following the charanga scheme units 'I wanna play in a band' and 'Zootime'</p> 	<p>In Geography we will be comparing and contrasting the UK to Kenya. We will use a map to locate Kenya, explore the climate and weather. We will learn about the animals and the people (Maasai tribe) and culture.</p>  <p>In History we will learn about Pocahontas. We will find out that she is not just a Disney character but was a native American woman who came to England in the eighteenth century.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">RE & PSHE</p> <p>In RE we will be learning about Muslims and how they live, learning the name of their god, when they pray and will retell stories about the prophet Muhammad. Our next topic is Easter and why it matters to Christians. We will learn the story of Holy Week.</p> <p>In PSHE we will continue to learn about health and well-being including exercise, diet and relaxation and how a Growth Mindset helps with school work.</p>
